Ingredients

- Plain white printer paper
- Glue
- Thin card (an empty cereal box is perfect)
- Decorations: glitter, sequins, beads, etc.. (optional)

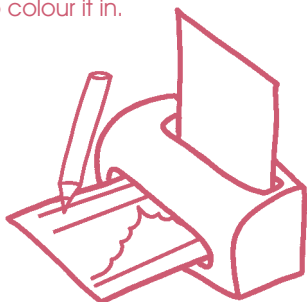
Equipment

- Computer printer
- Colouring pencils, crayons or felt pens
- Scissors



Instructions

- 1** Download and print out the outline of your princess tiara, and then use crayons, pencils or felt pens to colour it in.



- 2** Cover the back of the tiara with glue and stick it to a piece of thin cardboard. Smooth the paper down carefully so there are no wrinkles. Leave it to dry.



- 3** Cut around the tiara outline and also snip along the dotted lines at either end. (You might want to ask a grown-up to help out with this step.)



- 4** For a pretty princess finishing touch, use glitter glue, sequins, beads or stick-on jewels to decorate your tiara.



- 5** To finish, place the tiara on the princess's head to adjust to fit. Mark where ends need to be glued. Join the ends together, and wear with pride!



TOP TIP:

Scrunch up pieces of tissue paper and glue them to the tiara for a fabulous 3D effect. Shiny foil sweet wrappers work brilliantly, too!
